

KONKORS NAZZJONALI TAL-POEŻIJA DOREEN MICALLEF 2026

Regolamenti

Nirrakkomandaw lill-parteċipanti kollha li jaqraw ir-regoli bir-reqqa qabel ma jdaħħlu l-applikazzjoni tagħhom.

Regoli Ġenerali

1. Il-parteċipanti huma mitluba jibagħtu sa poeżija waħda bil-Malti, liema poeżija m'għandhiex tkun itwal minn sitta u tletin (36) vers.
2. Il-poeżija għandha tkun iffirmata biss bi psewdonimu (nom de plume).
3. Id-data tal-għeluq tal-konkors hija l-14 ta' Lulju 2026, f'nofsinhar.
4. Is-sottomissjonijiet għal dan il-konkors għandhom jsiru esklussivament online permezz tal-[formola tal-applikazzjoni online](#), sa mhux aktar tard mid-data tal-għeluq tal-konkors. Tintbagħat email ta' konferma awtomatika lill-applikanti meta jdaħħlu sottomissjoni permezz tal-formola tal-applikazzjoni online.
5. Is-sottomissjonijiet kollha jiġu kkunsidrati anonimament minn bord ta' ġurija u d-deċiżjoni tal-ġurija hija waħda finali. Il-ġurija tkun komposta minn tliet membri magħżula mill-Kunsill Nazzjonali tal-Ktieb.
6. Impjegati tal-Kunsill Nazzjonali tal-Ktieb ma jistgħux jieħdu sehem fil-Konkors.
7. Kull min jonqos f'xi waħda minn dawn ir-regolamenti jiġi skwalifikat immedjatament.

Il-poeżiji

8. Is-sottomissjonijiet kollha huma ġgudikati b'mod anonimu u l-isem tal-poeta m'għandu jidher imkien fuq il-poeżija.
9. Il-poeżiji kollha għandu jkollhom titlu u m'għandhomx jaqbzu sitta u tletin (36) vers (eskluz it-titlu). Il-poeżiji jistgħu jkunu fuq kwalunkwe sugġett.

10. Il-poeżiji għandhom ikunu x-xogħol originali tal-partecipant.
11. Ix-xogħol sottomess irid ikun originali u qatt ma gie ppubblikat f'kotba, rivisti, ġurnali, siti, fuq il-midja soċjali, jew kien fost ir-rebbieħa ta' konkorsi oħra qabel it-12 ta' Mejju 2026.

Ir-rebbieħa

12. Ir-rebbieħa jithabbru waqt ċerimonja ta' premjazzjoni matul il-Festival Nazzjonali tal-Ktieb 2026.
13. Jiġu ppremjati l-poeżiji kklassifikati fl-ewwel tliet postijiet. L-ewwel poeżija tingħata premju ta' €1,000. It-tieni u t-tielet poeżija jingħataw premju ta' €500 u €200 rispettivament. Il-premjijiet jistgħu ma jingħatawx jekk il-ġurija tqis li ma jkunx intlaħaq il-livell mistenni.
14. Id-drittijiet tal-awtur ta' kull poeżija jibqgħu f'idejn l-awtur. Madankollu, bil-partecipazzjoni tagħhom fil-konkors, l-awturi tal-poeżiji rebbieħa jagħtu lill-Kunsill Nazzjonali tal-Ktieb id-dritt li jippubblika u/jew ixandar il-poeżija rebbieħa tagħhom.

DOREEN MICALLEF NATIONAL POETRY CONTESTS 2026

Regulations

We recommend that all participants read the contest regulations carefully before submitting their application.

General Rules

1. Participants are invited to submit up to one poem in Maltese, which should not be longer than thirty-six (36) lines.
2. The poem should only be signed with a pseudonym (nom de plume).
3. The closing date of the contest is midday, 14 July 2026.
4. Entries should be submitted exclusively through the [online application form](#) by the closing date of the contest. An automatic confirmation email will be sent to applicants once they submit their application via the online application form on the National Book Council website.
5. All submissions are evaluated anonymously by an adjudication panel and its decision is final. The jury will be composed of three members appointed by the National Book Council.
6. Employees of the National Book Council may not participate.
7. Any participant who fails to comply with any of these regulations will be disqualified immediately.

The poems

8. All submissions are evaluated anonymously and the poet's name should not appear anywhere on the poem.
9. All poems should have a title and should not exceed thirty-six (36) lines (excluding the title). Poems can be on any subject.
10. The poems should be the original work of the participant.
11. The work submitted must be original and have never been published in books, magazines, journals, websites, on social media, or were among the winners of other competitions before May 12, 2026.

The winners

12. The winners will be announced at an awards ceremony during the 2026 Malta Book Festival.
13. The poems which rank in the top three will be awarded. The author of the first poem will receive a prize of €1,000. The authors of poems placing in second and third place will receive prizes of €500 and €200 respectively. Prizes may not be awarded if the jury deems that the expected level has not been reached.
14. The copyright of each poem remains with the author, however, by participating in the contest, the authors of the winning poems are giving the National Book Council the right to publish and / or broadcast in other media their winning poem.
