X'inhuma l-Ghotjiet għat-Traduzzjoni?

L-Ghotjiet għat-Traduzzjoni tal-Fond Malti tal-Ktieb jiffurmaw parti mill-istrategija tal-Kunsill Nazzjonali tal-Ktieb (KNK) biex jixpruna l-esportazzjoni u d-disseminazzjoni internazzjonali ta' pubblikazzjonijiet Maltin, u biex jesponi x-xenarju letterarju lokali għal xogħlijiet li għadhom ma gēwx maqluba u ppubblikati fil-Malti.

It-taqsimha tal-Ghotjiet għat-Traduzzjoni tal-Fond Malti tal-Ktieb tinqasam f'żewġ kategoriji:

- Kategorija 1 - Pubblikazzjoni ta' traduzzjoni ta' kotba Maltin
- Kategorija 2 - Pubblikazzjoni ta' traduzzjoni għall-Malti

Kategorija 1 - Traduzzjoni ta' kotba Maltin

Dil-kategorija tista' tiffinanzja applikazzjonijiet għal proġetti ta' pubblikazzjoni ta' traduzzjoni ta' xogħlijiet Maltin (ippubblikati bil-Malti jew bl-Ingliż f'Malta, u li jkollhom ISBN Malti) f'kull ilsien ieħor, b'allokazzjoni baġitarja totali ta' €40,000.

Xogħlijiet li jkunu se jinqalbu minn lingwa intermedjarja imma li jkunu nkitbu oriġinarjament bil-Malti se jkunu kkunsidrati wkoll, iżda tingħata prijorità lil dawk it-traduzzjonijiet li saru minn edizzjonijiet Maltin oriġinali.

Kategorija 2 - Traduzzjonijiet għall-Malti

Dil-kategorija tista' tiffinanzja applikazzjonijiet għal proġetti ta' pubblikazzjoni ta' traduzzjoni ta' xogħlijiet fil-Malti li oriġinarjament kienu ppubblikati f'kull lingwa oħra. L-allokazzjoni baġitarja totali hi ta' €15,000.

Iż-żewġ kategoriji jirrigwardjaw it-traduzzjoni ta' dawn it-tipi ta' xogħlijiet oriġinali:

- Letteratura (finzjoni, poezija, drammi, bijografiji, letteratura mhux fittizja u rumanzi grafiċi)
- Xogħol ta' riċerka, li jinkludu kotba akkademiċi (monografi, ġabriet editjati, edzzjonijiet kritiċi, katalgi rriċerkati ta' eżebizzjonijiet li jkunu jinkludu materjal analitiku frott ir-riċerka)

Ix-xogħol oriġinali jrid ikun diġà ġie ppubblikat u jrid ikun identifikat minn ISBN.

X'inhuma l-għanijiet tal-Ghotjiet għat-Traduzzjoni?

L-għanijiet ta' dal-fond huma:

- Biex tiżdied il-viżibiltà tal-kitba kreattiva u akkademika Maltija fuq pjattaformi internazzjonali.
- Biex il-kitba kreattiva u akkademika miktuba bil-Malti tiġi megħjuna taċċessa swieq u udjenzi internazzjonali.
- Biex jitwieżnu t-tradutturi Maltin li jridu jagħtu aċċess lill-pubbliku li jaqra bil-Malti għal xogħlijiet letterarji internazzjonali.

Liema proġetti jiffinanzjaw l-Għotjiet għat-Traduzzjoni?

L-iskema tidderieġi l-fondi lil tradutturi jew pubblikaturi eliġibbli għall-kofinanzjament tal-pubblikazzjoni tat-traduzzjoni ta' kotba ppubblikati minn u lejn l-ilsien Malti.

L-għotjiet għat-traduzzjoni jistgħu jiffinanzjaw sa 100% tal-ispejjeż għat-traduzzjoni sa massimu ta' €5,000, bir-rata ta' €0.10 kull kelma. Fil-każ tat-traduzzjoni tal-poeżija r-rata msemija ta' €0.10 kull kelma ma tgħoddx, u dan minhabba l-qosor tat-test poetiku. Fil-każ ta' proġett tat-traduzzjoni tal-poeżija qed jiġu aċċettati stimi li jirrelataw mal-proġett fis-sħuħija tiegħu.

L-applikanti jridu jipprovdu rendikont baġitarju tal-proġett bi provi ta' stimi uffiċjali.

Kull applikazzjoni tkun assessjata individwalment skont il-kriterji tal-għotjiet.

Jekk jogħġbokom aqraw bir-reqqa l-kriterji tal-eliġibbiltà u l-aġġudikazzjoni għall-fond qabel issawru l-proposta tagħkom jew tapplikaw għall-fondi.

Għidulna wkoll jekk irċivejtux fondi pubbliċi fl-imġhoddi u niżżlulna d-dati, l-ammont/i u dettali rilevanti oħra dwar il-fondi li kontu rċivejtu.

Ir-Regolament De Minimis - Regoli Applikabbli dwar Għajjnuna Statali

Il-Fond Malti tal-Ktieb ikun implimentat skont il-proviżjonijiet tar-Regolament tal-Kummissjoni (UE) No 1407/2013 tat-18 ta' Diċembru 2013 bit-tqegħid ta' Artikli 107 u 108 tat-Trattat dwar il-Funzjonament tal-Unjoni Ewropea dwar l-għajjnuna de minimis (OJ L 352/1 tal-24 ta' Diċembru 2013) - ir-regolament de minimis. L-għajjnuna de minimis totali mogħtija lil kull individwu m'għandhiex taqbeż il-€200,000 fuq perjodu ta' tliet snin fiskali. Minhabba f'hekk l-applikanti għal dal-fond mitluba jipprovdu Formola ta' Dikjarazzjoni t'Għajjnuna Statali li fiha jikkonfermaw l-ammont ta' għajjnuna de minimis li rċevew fis-sena fiskali kurrenti u fis-sentejn ta' qabilha.

L-akkumulu tal-għajjnuna għandu jsegwi r-regoli f'Artiklu 5 tad-de minimis. L-għajjnuna tal-Fond Maltit tal-Ktieb m'għandhiex tingħadd ma' għajjnuniet governattivi oħra li jkopru l-istess spejjeż. Jekk ikun jidher ċar li l-proġett ingħata fondi separati għall-istess spejjeż, ie. dak li jkun ikun bill sebgħu darbtejn, il-proposta tkun ikkunsidrata bħala ineliġibbli u l-fondi mogħtija jkunu jridu jitreggħu.

II-Proċess Evalwattiv

Ladarba l-applikazzjonijiet jaslu għandna l-ewwel ma nagħmlu niċċekkjawhom għall-eliġibbiltà. Dawk l-applikazzjonijiet li ma jkunux eliġibbli f'termini ta' proċedura ma jiġux proċessati u lanqas jgħaddu għall-fażi evalwattiva. L-applikazzjonijiet eliġibbli jgħaddu biex jiġu evalwati għand bord indipendenti.

L-għotjiet jiġu allokat wara proċess kompetittiv ta' aġġudikazzjoni skont damma ta' Kriterji stabbiliti.

Kull kriterju jkunlu allokat numru ta' marki. Biex proġett jitqies għall-fondi jrid iġib tal-inqas 60 marka.

Minkejja dan, is-sessjoni evalwativa u d-deċiżjonijiet għall-fondi jiddependu mil-livell ta' kompetizzjoni u l-fondi li jkun hemm. Jiġifieri jekk proġett iġib 60 marka jew aktar ma jfissirx li awtomatikament se jingħata l-fondi.

L-ordni tal-klassifikazzjoni tal-proġetti, skont il-marki mogħtija mill-evalwaturi, tkun ippubblikata online fi żmien 8 (tmien) ġimgħat minn meta jagħlqu l-applikazzjonijiet. L-ismijiet tal-proġetti rebbieħa biss jiġu ppubblikati.

Il-bord tal-aġġudikazzjoni jista' jkun jitlob xi kjarifiki mingħand l-applikant waqt is-sessjoni evalwativa; madankollu ma jfissirx li jekk jikkuntattjawk tal-bord il-proġett tiegħek ikun se jieħu l-fondi. Kull korrispondenza tintbagħat mill-amministratur tal-fondi tal-Kunsill Nazzjonali tal-Ktieb.

II-Kriterji tal-Eligibbiltà

L-applikazzjonijiet l-ewwel jiġu ċċekkjati skont it-termini tal-eligibbiltà, u għandhom jintbagħtu mimlija u jkunu jinkludu: id-deskrizzjoni tal-proġett, rendikont baġitarju, ittra ta' interess jew impenn minn pubblikatur, u skeda taż-żmien approssimattiva.

Id-deskrizzjoni tal-proġett

Bħala parti mill-applikazzjoni, l-applikant irid jikteb deskrizzjoni konċiża tal-proġett tat-traduzzjoni ta' mhux aktar minn 1,000 kelma. Din għandha tinkludi deskrizzjoni tal-valur kulturali għas-suq Malti tal-pubblikazzjoni jew tal-valur letterarju esportattiv, dejjem skont il-kategorija li tkun applikajt għaliha, kif ukoll il-pjan għall-pubblikazzjoni mingħand il-pubblikatur li għalih it-traduzzjoni tkun immirata.

Il-proġett m'għandux ikun kummerċjalment vijabbli, jew imantni lill-nnifsu bis-saħħa ta' rotot stabbiliti. It-traduzzjoni ta' kotba għall-qari każwali, kotba ta' noti mużikali u kotba li jkun fihom biss xbihat jew tal-fotografija huma esklużi minn din l-iskema.

Id-deskrizzjoni trid tinkludi għala l-proġett għandu jiġi kkunsidrat għall-fondi, u magħhom il-ġustifikazzjonijiet għall-fondi.

Il-finanzi tal-proġett - ir-rendikont baġitarju

L-applikazzjoni għandha tinkludi ġustifikazzjoni tal-fondi pprovduti fil-biċċa dwar il-finanzi u rendikont baġitarju tal-proġett, sabiex il-proposta tkun sostnuta. F'dil-fażi tal-applikazzjoni trid tipprovi kopji ta' stimi relevanti li jagħtu hjiel approssimattiv tal-ispejjeż involuti (niżżel il-qafas tar-rendikont baġitarju - APP 3) u magħhom il-prova ta' stimi uffiċjali. Id-dokumentazzjoni uffiċjali trid tinfed ir-rendikont baġitarju u l-ispejjeż tal-proġett. Dawn l-ispejjeż jistgħu jinqasmu hekk:

- ir-rati tat-traduzzjoni
- l-ispejjeż tat-traduttur/i
- il-qari tal-provi
- l-editjar
- l-ispejjeż tal-aġenti barranin/miżati għad-drittijiet ta' barra
- stampar
- h̄lasijiet oħra

Imla dawk il-kategoriji li japplikaw għat-tip ta' għotja li qed tapplika għaliha. Fl-istadju finali tar-rapport, u jekk tingħata l-fond, imla l-kolonna jisimha 'Finali' fir-rendikont baġitarju u erga' ssottometti, did-darba b'fatturi, irċevuti, u dokumentazzjoni oħra rilevanti għal kull kategorija mir-rendikont baġitarju li jeħtieġlek timla għall-għotja tiegħek.

Ir-rendikont baġitarju jrid ikun fih dawk l-ammonti assigurati, mhux assigurati, u dħul ippjanat ieħor. L-ammont mhux assigurat mitlub mill-fond irid ikun ikkwantifikat u allokat tali mod li jkun jaqbel mat-talba tiegħek mill-fond.

NB: Kull rendikont baġitarju jeħtieġ li jinkludi kemm in-nefqa u anki d-dħul minn xi għejjun ieħor ta' fondi. Dawn l-għejjun ta' fondi jew sponsors (anki l-isponsors mhux finanzjarji) iridu jintrifdu mid-dokumentazzjoni rilevanti.

Skedi taż-żmien

Id-data tal-pubblikazzjoni ta' kull proġett rebbieh tiġi nnegożjata mal-Kunsill Nazzjonali tal-Ktieb wara li jithabbru r-rebbieha u skont il-kuntratt tal-benefiċjarju. Trid tisemma data approssimattiva ta' meta t-traduzzjoni se titlesta fid-deskrizzjoni konċiża, u din ma tridx taqbeż it-18-il xahar (18) mid-data tal-kuntratt mal-benefiċjarju.

Proġetti ineligibbli

Dawk l-applikazzjonijiet għall-għotjiet li jaqgħu f'dawn il-kategoriji mhumiex eligibbli għall-fondi:

- kotba tal-iskola, manwali ta' istruzzjoni;
- kotba annwali;
- xogħlijiet ta' propoganda;
- kotba ta' qari każwali, kotba ta' noti muzikali u kotba li jkun fihom biss xbihat jew tal-fotografija;
- moduli jew xogħlijiet ta' traduzzjoni mgħallma f'xi kors;
- spejjeż li jkunu diġà ġew koperti minn organizzazzjonijiet kulturali pubbliċi, jew bi programmi ta' fondi oħra mmaniġġjati jew komaniġġjati mill-Kunsill Nazzjonali tal-Ktieb, jew kull aġenzija pubblika oħra, department governattiv jew Ministeru;
- spejjeż b'lura;
- applikazzjonijiet b'informazzjoni nieqsa (irreferi għal-lista ta' dokumenti mitluba hawn taħt).

Proposti li ma jsegwux il-kriterji tal-eligibbiltà ma jiġux proċessati u ma jgħaddux għall-fażi evalwattiva.

II-Kriterji tal-Agġudikazzjoni

Kull applikazzjoni eligibbli tkun evalwata skont kriterji tal-agġudikazzjoni stabbiliti f'dawn il-linji-gwida u r-regoli. Il-kriterji qegħdin hemm biex jagħtu rotta lil dawk l-inizjattivi li jkollhom valur kulturali, avolja ma jkunux kummerċjalment vijabbli, u dan skont l-agġudikazzjoni tal-bord.

- ➔ Il-bord tal-agġudikazzjoni jista' jaqtagħha li jagħti fondi parzjali jew shaħ lil proġett partikolari jew applikazzjoni.
- ➔ Il-bord tal-agġudikazzjoni se jibbaża l-ġudizzju tiegħu fuq is-saħħa u l-kompletezza tal-applikazzjoni.

- ➔ Il-bord tal-aġġudikazzjoni jista' jiddiskrimina fil-mod kif iqassam il-fondi lil xi applikazzjonijiet biex ikun jista' jilhaq il-miri tal-fondi skont ċerti prijoritajiet li l-bord ikun iqis importanti għas-suq lokali tal-kotba.
- ➔ Id-deċiżjoni tal-bord tal-aġġudikazzjoni hija finali u mhux kontestabbli.
- ➔ L-applikanti jistgħu jissottomettu aktar minn applikazzjoni waħda f'kull fergħa tal-Fond, iżda waħda minnhom biss tingħata l-fond f'dik il-fergħa li tkun.
- ➔ Jitiqiesu eliġibbli biss dawk il-proġetti ta' traduzzjoni li jkollhom diġà pjan għall-pubblikazzjoni fis-seħħ, ie. ittra ta' interess mingħand pubblikatur, lokali jew barrani skont il-kategorija li għaliha ssir l-applikazzjoni. Barra minn hekk, fil-każ ta' xogħlijiet f'kategorija 1 - traduzzjoni ta' kotba Maltin - kull pjan irid ikun strettament iffukat lejn publikazzjoni b'ISBN barrani. Fil-każ ta' xogħlijiet f'kategorija 2 - traduzzjonijiet għall-Malti - tingħata preferenza lil applikanti li jippubblikaw b'ISBN lokali.

lċ-ċarezza tal-applikazzjoni u l-livell ta' dettal provdut. (10 marki)

Il-kapaċità tal-applikant li jimmaniġġja l-proġett (li tinkludi l-immaniġġjar finanzjarju) b'responsabbiltà u b'suċċess. (10 marki)

Tingħata preferenza lil:

- Proġetti li ma jkunux kummerċjalment vijabbli, minkejja l-importanza tagħhom.
- Applikazzjonijiet li jipprovdu deskrizzjoni ddettaljata ta' proċess ta' publikazzjoni li jkun għaddej, fosthom ittra ta' interess/impenn mingħand publikatur.
- Applikazzjonijiet li jkunu sostnuti minn terzi persuni bis-saħħa ta' referenza legittima.

- Applikazzjonijiet b'rendikont baġitarju realistiku u mirfud bi stimi uffiċjali.

What are the Translation Grants?

The Malta Book Fund Translation Grants form part of the National Book Council's strategy to boost the export and international dissemination of Maltese publications, and to open up Malta's literary landscape to works which have as yet not been published in translation into the Maltese language.

The Translation Grants section of the Malta Book Fund is divided into two categories:

- Category 1 - Publication of translations of Maltese books
- Category 2 - Publication of translations into Maltese

Category 1 - Translations of Maltese books

The category supports applications for the publication of translation projects of Maltese works (published in the Maltese or English language in Malta with a Maltese ISBN) into any other language, with an annual allocated budget of €40,000.

Works which are going to be translated through a bridge language translation but which were originally written in the Maltese language will be considered, but priority will be given to works translated from original Maltese editions.

Category 2 - Translations into Maltese

The category supports applications for the publication of the translation into Maltese of works originally published in any other language. The annual allocated budget for category 2 is €15,000.

Both categories of the programme address the translation of the following types of original works:

- literature (fiction, poetry, drama, biographies, literary nonfiction and graphic novels)
- works of research including academic and scholarly books (monographs, edited collections, critical editions, researched exhibition and gallery catalogues containing analytical material that is the result of research.)

The original work needs to have been already published and identified by its ISBN.

What are the objectives of the Translation grants?

The objectives of the grants are:

- to increase the visibility of Maltese creative and academic writing on international platforms;
- to help creative and academic writing in the Maltese language access international markets and audiences;
- to support Maltese translators in bringing international works of literature and research to a Maltese-reading public.

What do the Translation grants support?

The scheme offers grants to eligible translators or publishers for the co-financing of the publication of the translation of published books to and from the Maltese language.

The translation grants may support up to 100% of the translation fees or up to a maximum of € 5,000 at a rate of €0.10 per word. The latter rate of €0.10 per word does not apply for translations of poetry due to the limited wordcount of poetry translation projects. In the case of poetry translations, a quote per project will be accepted.

Applicants must provide a budget breakdown of the project, with proofs of official quotes.

Each application will be assessed individually on the basis of the criteria of the grant.

Please make sure you read the eligibility and adjudication criteria for each grant carefully before building your proposal and applying for funds.

Please state whether you have already received public funding in the past and list the dates, amount specifications and any other relevant details about the funds received.

When available, clearly dated copies of press cuttings (including printouts of online press material) that may further the applicant's cause are to be attached to the application.

De Minimis Regulation - Applicable State Aid Rules

The Malta Book Fund is implemented in line with provisions of Commission Regulation (EU) No 1407/2013 of 18 December 2013 on the application of Articles 107 and 108 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union to de minimis aid (OJ L 352/1 of 24 December 2013) - the de minimis Regulation. The total de minimis aid granted to any single undertaking shall not exceed €200,000 over any period of three fiscal years. To this end, applicants are being requested to provide a signed State Aid Declaration Form confirming the amount of de minimis aid received during the current and two previous fiscal years.

Rules on cumulation of aid shall be in line with Article 5 of the de minimis Regulation. Assistance under the Malta Book Fund cannot be accumulated with any other government funded scheme for the same costs. Should it become apparent that any project has been awarded separate funds for the same costs, i.e. double dipping, the proposal will be considered ineligible and/or funds will have to be reimbursed if already paid.

The Evaluation Process

Once received, applications will be first screened for eligibility. Applications which are not eligible in terms of the procedure stipulated by these guidelines will not be processed further and will not undergo evaluation. Eligible applications will be passed on to an independent adjudication board who will evaluate the projects.

The grants will be awarded to successful applicants following a competitive adjudication process according to established adjudication criteria.

Each criterion is allocated a specific number of marks. In order to be considered for funding, projects have to obtain at least 60 marks.

Nevertheless, the evaluation session and funding decisions depend on the level of competition and on the availability of the funds. Obtaining 60 marks or more does not automatically mean that you will be receiving the funds.

The order of classification of the winning projects, according to the marks allocated by the evaluators, will be published online within 8 (eight) weeks from the application deadline. Only the names of the successful beneficiaries and their projects will be published.

The adjudication board may require clarifications from the applicant during the evaluation sessions; however, being contacted by the board does not mean that that project will necessarily be funded. All correspondence will be sent by the National Book Council's Fund Administrator.

Eligibility Criteria

Applications are first screened in terms of eligibility and are to be complete and include: the project description, a budget breakdown, a letter of interest/commitment and the estimated timeframe.

Project description

As part of the application, the applicant must write a brief description of the translation publication project not exceeding 1,000 words, which should include a description of its cultural value for the Maltese publishing market or its literary export value, depending on the category applied for, as well as the intended publisher's plans for its publication.

The project must not be potentially commercially viable and self-sustainable via already established routes. Translation of coffee-table books, musical scores and books based solely on imagery or photography are excluded from the scheme.

The brief should explain why the project requires funding.

Project costing - budget breakdown

The application should include a justification of the funding provided in the costing and a budget breakdown of the project in order to support your proposal. At application stage, provide copies of any relevant quotations that can give an indication of estimated costs (see downloadable budget breakdown table template - APP 3), with proofs of official quotes. Official documentation must be submitted in support of the budget breakdown of the project costs. These can be broken down as follows:

- translation rates
- translator/s' fees
- proofreading
- editing
- foreign agents' fees/foreign rights fees
- printing
- other payments

You may fill in relevant entries only pertaining to the specific grant/category applied for. At final report stage, and if the grant is awarded, fill out the 'actuals' column of the budget breakdown and resubmit with invoices, receipts and other relevant documentation for each item listed in the budget sheet.

The budget sheet must include amounts relating to secured, unsecured and other planned revenues. The unsecured amount requested from the fund must be quantified and allocated as the 'amount requested' from the fund.

NB: Every budget must include both expenditure and income through other sources of funding. Other sources of funding and sponsorships (including sponsorships in kind) must be supported by relevant documentation.

Timeframes

The publication date for each winning project will be negotiated with the National Book Council upon the release of the winners' list and established within the beneficiaries contract.

An estimated completion date of the translation should be mentioned in the project brief and should not exceed 18 months from the date indicated in the beneficiary's contract.

Ineligible projects

Applications for translation grants in the following areas are ineligible for funding:

- textbooks, instruction manuals;
- yearbooks;
- works whose primary objective is party propaganda;
- coffee-table books, musical scores and books based solely on imagery or photography;
- modules or translation work within a taught course;
- expenses already covered by public cultural organisations, or another public funding programme managed or co-managed by the National Book Council, or any other public agency, government department or Ministry;
- retrospective costs;
- incomplete applications (please refer to documents checklist below).

Ineligible proposals in terms of the eligibility criteria listed above shall not be processed further and shall not undergo evaluation.

Adjudication Criteria

Each eligible application is evaluated against the adjudication criteria established in these guidelines and regulations. The criteria cater for as many different initiatives as possible, giving a chance to compete to all projects that prove to be of cultural value, albeit not commercially viable, based on the evaluation of the adjudication board.

- ➔ The adjudication board may decide to fully or partially fund a particular project or application.
- ➔ The adjudication board will base judgment on the strength and completeness of each application.

- ➔ The adjudicating board may discriminate against applications so as to set funding targets for grants according to certain priorities that the adjudication board deems to be of importance in the current circumstances of the book market.
- ➔ The adjudication board's decision is final and non-contestable.
- ➔ Applicants may submit more than one application in each and every fund strand, however only one of the applications will be funded within that strand.
- ➔ Only translation projects with a planned publication process in place will be considered eligible, i.e. a letter of interest from a foreign publisher or a local publisher, depending on the category applied for. Moreover, in the case of category 1, Translations of Maltese books, all plans should be strictly directed at publishing with a foreign ISBN. In category 2, Translations into Maltese, preference will be given to applicants publishing with a local ISBN.

The Translation Grants section of the Malta Book Fund is divided into two categories, each with its own set of criteria:

- Category 1 – Translations of Maltese books with an annual total allocated budget of €40,000;
- Category 2 – Translations into Maltese with an annual total allocated budget of €15,000.

Rules and regulations apply to each specific grant.

Category 1 - TRANSLATIONS OF MALTESE BOOKS

Adjudicators will evaluate applications on the basis of the following criteria to reach a final assessment. The project description should elaborate on each of the three criteria, as outlined below:

1. Quality of the proposed project
2. International engagement
3. Management and feasibility

1. Quality of the proposed project – TOTAL: 40 MARKS

The strength of the translator's professional record, the quality of the sample provided (a CV/Portfolio of the translator, a letter of interest/commitment and a sample of the translators' work should be submitted with the application) (35 marks)

Automatic points will be granted as follows:

* if the published work has been awarded the National Book Prize (5 marks)

2. International engagement – TOTAL: 40 MARKS

Details of the plan for international distribution, dissemination and promotion of the translated work. This criterion considers the level of detail and contacts (foreign publisher) already established supported with relevant documentation, including, if any, a letter of interest/of commitment for the publication of the translation. (30 marks)

Relevance of the work to be translated to the target international market. This criterion requires knowledge of the market targeted and an explanation as to why that specific

work is targeting the selected market. (10 marks)

3. Management and feasibility – TOTAL: 20 MARKS

The clarity of the application and the level of detail provided. (10 marks)

The applicant's ability to manage the project (including financial management) responsibly and successfully. (10 marks)

Category 2 - TRANSLATIONS INTO MALTESE

Adjudicators will evaluate applications on the basis of the following criteria to reach a final assessment. The project description should elaborate on each of the three criteria, as outlined below:

1. Quality of the proposed project
2. Domestic engagement
3. Management and feasibility

1. Quality of the proposed project – TOTAL: 40 MARKS

The strength of the translator's professional record, the quality of the sample provided (a CV/Portfolio of the translator and a sample of the translators' work should be submitted with the application). (30 marks)

The cultural, educational, academic or literary significance of the publication being translated for publication. (10 marks)

2. Domestic engagement – TOTAL: 40 MARKS

Details of the plan for domestic distribution, dissemination and promotion of the translated work. This criterion considers the level of detail and contacts already established supported with relevant documentation, including a letter of commitment for the publication of the translation. (30 marks)

Relevance of the work to be translated for publication in the domestic market. This criterion requires knowledge of the market segment targeted and an explanation as to why that specific work is targeting the particular segment. (10 marks)

3. Management and feasibility – TOTAL: 20 MARKS

The clarity of the application and the level of detail provided. (10 marks)

The applicant's ability to manage the project (including financial management) responsibly and successfully. (10 marks)

Preference is given to:

- Projects which may not be commercially viable despite their importance.

- Applications which provide a reasonable description of a planned publication process in place, including a letter of interest/commitment from the publisher.
- Applications which are supported by third-parties via a legitimate written reference.
- Applications with realistic budgets and backed by official quotes.

How to apply and deadline

Before submitting an application, applicants are strongly encouraged to read these guidelines and regulations very carefully.

The application form can be downloaded from ktieb.org.mt/malta-book-fund together with all necessary supporting documentation.

The call for applications closes on Wednesday 30 June 2022 at 12:00 noon.

A pack with four identical printed and signed copies of the application, bound in individual flat files or punch file folders, must still be mailed to the National Book Council offices at the address provided here (see FAQs for more details on how to submit the application). Please note:

- It is your responsibility to present a complete application form as explained in these guidelines and regulations. If you do not present all the necessary information, then your application will not be processed as it will be considered ineligible.
- Whether you are applying as an individual or a company, please make sure you include the official address, contact number and e-mail address in your application. Also make sure you sign and date (date of completion of application) every document before making the identical and complete four copies of the application pack.

- Applications handed in or mailed/couriered after 12.00 (noon) of the aforementioned deadline cannot be accepted.

Mandatory Documents Checklist

The mandatory documents listed below need to be submitted together with the application form and are required for the pre-evaluation screening.

A decision on funding will be made based on the strength of the submitted information. Failure to provide any of these documents will render the application ineligible.

1. Complete, signed and dated Application Form specifying which Grants and/or Categories are being applied for.
2. Project proposal (1,000 words for translation projects).
3. Budget breakdown (including copies of relevant official quotes).
4. A copy of the applicant's ID card (front and back) or residence permit or citizenship certificate or passport.
5. Translator's CV/portfolio.
6. A sample of the translated work.
7. An excerpt from the work to be translated (source text) corresponding with the sample translation.
8. Letter of interest/commitment from the local or international publisher, depending on the category applied for.
9. The State Aid Declaration Form.

Other non-mandatory documents are:

10. Any references and/or press cuttings supporting the proposed project.
11. A list, if any, of any public funds awarded in the past.

Kindly note that it is your responsibility to submit all the necessary documentation, as outlined above, by the indicated deadline.

Upon request, National Book Council representatives can discuss details of the application process with the applicant prior to the submission date, but are not authorised to fill in any parts of your application OR to check your application form prior to submission.

Communication of Results

The results of each respective grant and category will be published online on www.ktieb.org.mt within 8 (eight) weeks from the application deadline. Only the names of the successful projects will be published with the order of classification of the projects, according to the marks allocated by the adjudication board. No other information on the evaluation process will be released.

On the day indicated above, applicants will receive the results notification from the National Book Council, including a copy of the order of classification of the projects, according to the marks allocated by the adjudication board according to the fund criteria.

Failure to qualify does not bar the applicant from applying again in the following call for applications with the same or a different project.

Processing of personal data

All information received by the fund administrators and adjudicators will be considered confidential, both during and after the evaluation process. Provisions on data protection and confidentiality for successful projects will be included in the grant agreement with the fund beneficiaries.

Enquiries

The decisions made by the adjudication board is final.

Please provide a detailed explanation and justification of the request supported by relevant documentation, if any.

You will normally receive a reply within fifteen (15) working days.

Project implementation and monitoring

If your application is approved and funded, you will be requested to sign a contract specifying the conditions of the fund. When accepting the grant, applicants accept that their name, the project title and the amount awarded can be published by the National Book Council.

50% (fifty per cent) of the total amount allocated by the adjudication board to a specific project will be awarded upon signing of the grant beneficiaries contract. The other 50% (fifty per cent) will be released following approval by the National Book Council of the final report, and submission and tallying of final invoices and receipts within the budget breakdown.

The Fund beneficiaries must use the National Book Council's logo on all related material and specify that the project was supported by the Malta Book Fund – in all marketing, PR and printed material. The grant received must be used solely for the purpose for which it was awarded, in line with the submitted proposal and the contract.

Beneficiaries must notify the National Book Council immediately if changes affecting the nature of the project take place during implementation. Changes cannot be implemented unless approval is received. The National Book Council reserves the right to revise or withhold the final payment if the change in the project is not considered to be in line with the initial proposal, or if the Council is not informed of the changes within a reasonable time.

Reporting

Upon completion of the project, applicants will be required to submit a detailed report (see APP 4) including invoices and receipts and highlighting the work carried out and the achievements of the project upon its conclusion, by not later than eighteen (18) months after signing the fund beneficiary contract.

Together with this report, beneficiaries must submit 2 hard copies of the published translated book, and any relevant marketing, publicity or information material developed for the funded project, including visual documentation, if any, and an updated budget breakdown table highlighting actual expenditure (see APP 3).

The National Book Council retains the right to make use of submitted project material.

The information provided will be evaluated by the National Book Council fund administrators and, if this information is satisfactory, then the final 50% of the amount allocated by the fund will be granted. The amount will be adjusted based on the invoices and receipts received.

The National Book Council reserves the right to revise the final payment if the project was not delivered as indicated in the application form.

Likewise, the National Book Council retains the right to recover funds in case these are not being used and/or are misused and/or are not used according to the submitted proposal and budget.

Appendix I. Definition of terms used in the Malta Book Fund scheme

Adjudication board

The board of adjudicators, appointed by the National Book Council to adjudicate and distribute funds among applicants.

Applicant

Applicant is the Malta-based individual or a Maltese registered or international publisher, or legally recognised organisation applying for the grant.

Application

An application is a submission, inclusive of all mandatory documents and any annexes to the application form, made by an eligible applicant.

Author

A person who has published, or has had published, a minimum of one book, or a story or article in book form.

Beneficiary

The recipient of the grant. The beneficiary is responsible for the implementation of the proposal supported by the Malta Book Fund – Translation Grant.

Book

A printed publication that carries an ISBN.

Eligibility

Applications will first be screened in terms of eligibility. Proposals which are not considered eligible in terms of the set criteria will not be processed further and shall not undergo evaluation.

Grant

A grant may be a publishing, educational or foreign-promotion grant issued by the NBC.

Maltese books

Books in English or Maltese published in Malta and carrying a Maltese ISBN.

Melitensia

Books, electronic or not, published in Malta, or by Maltese authors, or about Malta, or in the Maltese language, or about any aspect of Maltese studies by any author.

New title

A new title is a book with more than 50% original content.

New edition

A new edition is the publication in modified form of a book previously published by the same or a different publisher.

- In contrast with a new title, a book is considered a new edition if more than 50% of its content is taken from the previously published book.
- In contrast with a reprint, a new edition must have at least one of the following:
 1. substantial changes in the format or binding;
 2. either substantial changes to at least 25% of the original written content or at least 25% new written content;
 - or 3. substantial changes to the illustrations, other than on the cover.

For the purposes of this Fund, New Editions of Out of Print Works must be noteworthy for their cultural, literary, academic significance (“the purpose of the Fund is to subsidise quality publications of high cultural, educational and intellectual value that in the context of the local market are not seen as commercially viable and thus would otherwise remain unpublished”), and have been out of print for at least 20 (twenty) years before the date of the publication of the current Malta Book Fund call, as well as having more than 50% of its content taken from the previously published book; have substantial changes in the format or binding, or either substantial changes to at least 25% of the original written content or at least 25% new written content, or substantial changes to the illustrations, other than on the cover.

Project

The book the applicant is planning to publish with funds from the Malta Book Fund.

Publisher

Person or group of persons who own a publishing house that has published a minimum of one book by one author.

Reprint

A subsequent printing of a book already published that preserves the identical text of the previous printing.

Textbook

A publication used as a standard work for the study of a particular subject at school (all levels).

Translator

A person who has translated a minimum of one translated book, or a story or article in book form, or can prove literary translation skillset.

Translation Grant

A grant awarded under category 1 or category 2 of the Malta Book Fund - Translation Grants supporting the publication of the translation of published literature identified by an ISBN (fiction, literary non-fiction, poetry, drama, biographies, academic works, and graphic novels).

Translation Pitch

In short, a book pitch (or proposal) should capture what the book is about and why people should be interested in reading it. You can pitch an agent in person at a meeting or conference, but a pitch can also be written [out in the form of a query letter](#).

A book translation pitch is slightly different in that its interlocutor is the foreign rights agent or literary agent or foreign publisher. In general, pitches should be brief.

There's one other major difference between pitching a new book and a book in translation: how much of the book/translation you need to have written in advance and what type of material the pitch pack should include.

Your translation pitch letter for the purposes of this fund application (no more than 1,000 words) should include:

- An Advanced Information Sheet or AI (presentation of the book, press reviews, information on the author, purpose of the book (non-fiction) or plot details (fiction) and the main points or topics of the book in short paragraphs, information about the author (previous books, sales history, prizes, films based on their novels etc.);
- How you became interested in translating the specific book: an explanation as to why you are so enthusiastic about the book and why you think it is appropriate for that particular publisher (reference to other titles in their list) and/or market
- A sample chapter (around 3,500 words, enough to give a flavour of the book): the original excerpt to be translated if the funds are granted;

- Facts and figures: length, number of words/pages. Sales figures/bestseller placings in the country of publication and in translation in other countries (which you can obtain from the original publisher);
- Your own résumé (relevant translating experience and credentials of the translator, if any);
- Factors affecting the publisher's decision: how the book was received in its source publishing market and why it is suitable for the chosen target market; length; cost of translation of the whole book:
- BONUS INFO: Is the author alive, 'promotable', available for launch? Is the book part of a series? Is the country of origin fashionable? Can the editor read the language or will s/he need to rely on an outside reader/bridge translation? Links to social media pages or author sites. Any other marketing material to be used to make the title in question as desirable as possible for foreign publishers
- Can you or who represents you fight for and win this book in an editorial meeting?
- Research outcome performed to identify foreign rights holder of the book.

Yearbook

A yearly publication containing information and statistics about the past activities.
