







Jean's work increased since he would often check the progress of the project that was so important for the Maltese Islands.




Malta Community of Illustrators and Arts Council Malta present:

Interactive Mural

Several members and artists from the Malta Community of Illustrators will be live-drawing an interactive mural during the Malta Book Festival. The mural will be emphasising the importance of illustration as a tool for positive change and social commentary, where illustrators will be invited to use their own individual style to create large-scale artwork, while keeping the literary setting of the mural in mind. The mural will be directed by Matthew Demarco, co-founder and creative director of local design studio Bloom Creative/Maltatype. Audience members will be free to contribute to the mural as it is being created.

Moira Scicluna Zahra, the founder of the Malta Community of Illustrators, has been working on a research paper through MCAST on the subject of contemporary Maltese illustrations. After carrying out various interviews with local illustrators, there has been an overwhelming appeal to use the medium of illustration as a device for social commentary and activism. Illustration is an art industry that has been described as 'at the service of the people' due to its universality, and it is therefore adequately placed to reach the public – in this case through a large-scale collaborative illustration. The aim of this project is to invite the audience to reflect and discuss.
